The Women Behind the Work

Every product at Shop @ VIHAAN is more than fabric and thread. It carries the story of a woman who has faced unimaginable challenges – and chosen resilience.

In our Bangalore production unit, survivors of trafficking, child marriage, and abandonment are finding safety, training, and dignified work. With every bag you carry, you carry their courage too.

Swathi's Story

Forced into child marriage and later trafficked, Swathi* was rescued in 2021 and brought to a VIHAAN shelter. Here she completed her Class 10 exams and began training in fashion design. Today, she helps create bags, pouches, and yoga mat covers – while also learning business management and procurement.

Nina's Story

Nina* grew up separated from her family, moving between government shelter homes in Tamil Nadu and Karnataka. Life was uncertain, and opportunities were few. She studied, helped in kitchens, and trained as a beautician – but when she turned 18, with no family, her future felt fragile.

That changed when VIHAAN introduced tailoring training at her aftercare home. Nina enrolled, eager to learn. What started as stitching simple seams soon grew into a wealth of skills – making garments, bags, and pouches, managing stock, and recording production details. She gained not only technical expertise but also confidence, communication skills, and leadership qualities.

Recognising her potential, the VIHAAN team gave her extra responsibilities. Nina became a key member of the production unit, helping to ensure orders were delivered and standards were met. For the first time, she could imagine a future built on her own strengths.

Nina's training and experience opened doors: she successfully secured a tailoring job at a nearby garment factory. Today, she earns ₹10,000–13,000 each month, with benefits like PF and ESI – and the pride of standing on her own feet.
